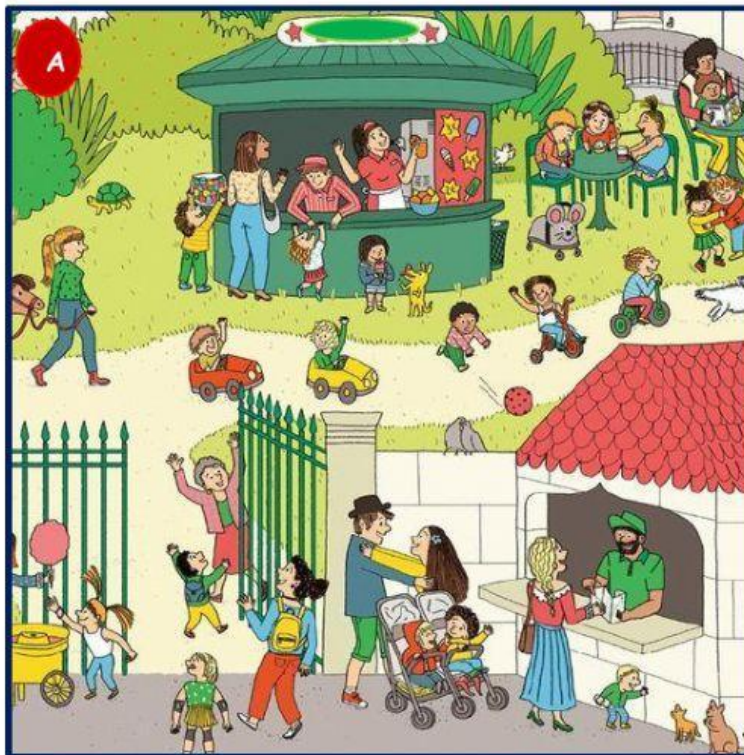

Fish and chips, a great British dish

Fish and chips is a famous British dish. There are about ten thousand and five hundred chippies (fish and chip shops) in the UK. Every village has at least one chippy. People say



the best fish and chips are in seaside towns. The fish is huge, golden and crispy. If you go on a day trip to the seaside, you have to have fish and chips! People form a queue to get their fish 'n' chips and they are wrapped in newspaper. The fish is fried in batter in deep vats, for about six minutes. Chips take a bit longer to fry. They are



served with salt and vinegar. Most chippies also serve other items: mushy peas, sausages, scallops, pies, gravy and curry

sauce. The dish - fried fish and chips served together - dates back to the 1860s. A Jewish immigrant, Joseph Malin, opened the first fish shop in London. The fish is usually cod or haddock. This used to be an everyday dish, an ordinary meal, but nowadays, it is a special treat because the price of fish has gone up. If you have fish 'n' chips once in a while, it is quite healthy. However, it is too fatty to eat every day - and too expensive!
