

QUESTION? time Past Simple

Except TO BE, CAN and some other verbs, you need **HELP** to make a question.

In the **Present** tense, you use **DO** or **DOES**.

Affirmative:

YOU **LIKE** the film.

Question:

DO YOU **LIKE** the film?

In the **Past** tense, you use **DID** (in all the persons, singular and plural!)



Affirmative:

YOU **LIKED** the film.

Question:

DID YOU **LIKE** the film?
