

# QUESTION? time **Past Simple**

Except TO BE, CAN and some other verbs, you need **HELP** to make a question.

In the **Present** tense, you use **DO** or **DOES**.

Affirmative:

YOU

LIKE

the film.

Question:

DO

YOU

LIKE

the film?

In the **Past** tense, you use **DID** (in all the persons, singular and plural!)



Affirmative:

YOU

LIKED

the film.

Question:

DID

YOU

LIKE

the film?

 Write **DO, DOES** or **DID** to make the sentence a QUESTION.

Transform the Present tense in the Past tense. **Present** ►► **Past**

Do you like broccoli now?

*Did you like broccoli* some years ago?

Do you speak English now?

two years ago?

Do you go to school today?

yesterday?

Do you play tennis today?

yesterday?

Do you like pizza now?

two years ago?

Do you go by car today?

yesterday?

Do you have a dog now?

two years ago?

Do you know the alphabet now?

two years ago?

Does it snow in May?

last January?

Do you understand it now?

before?

Do you have many tests this year?

last year?
