PRESENT PERFECT – USES		PAST SIMPLE- USES	
-Action that started in the past and has a link to the present	I've cleaned the car - it looks new!	-I went there last summer	Once or + in the past
-There is no exact time in which it occurred:		-I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they went	Same form
✓ yet	Have you seen it yet?	-I played	regular -ed
	Ya/todavía ?/N	-I didn't	negative form
✓ just	I have just heard it	-Did I infin.	Question form
	Acabo de +	-Remember the order using:	
✓ already	Mary has already baked it	ASI: Auxiliary+Subject+Infinitive	
	Ya +	or	Did you go?
✓ ever	Have you ever been here?	QuASI: Question Word+Auxiliary+Subject+Infinitive	When did you go?

PRESENT PERFECT VS PAST SIMPLE (2)

He was married for ten years (he's divorced or dead)	(acabada) (past simple)
He got married ten years ago (he is married now)	(inacabada) (present perfect)
