-Put them in the right position



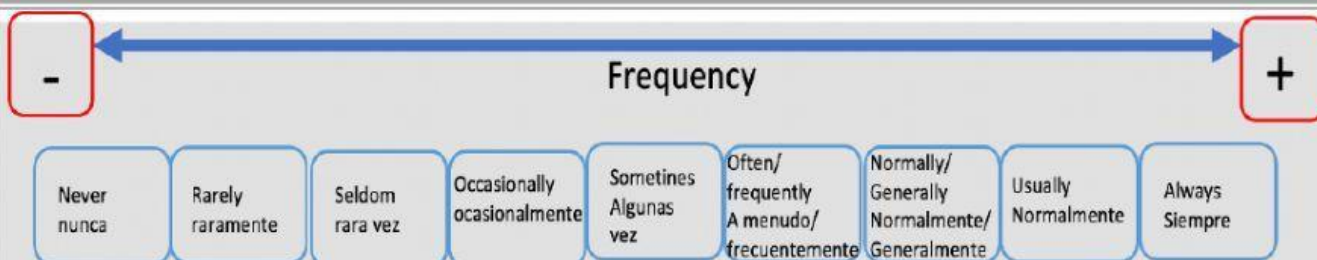
I always have lunch

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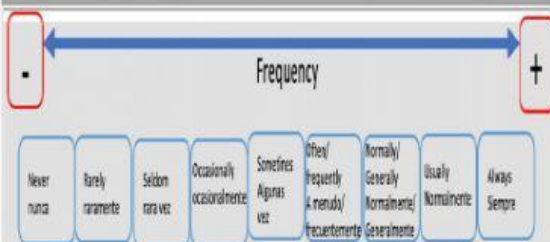
