	(-) S + should not / shouldn't + V-inf.	S + could not / couldn't + V-inf.
	(?) Should + S + V-inf? • Yes, S + should. • No, S + shouldn't.	Could + S + V-inf? • Yes, S + could. • No, S + couldn't.
	Wh-questions + should + S + V-inf?	Wh-questions + could + S + V-inf?

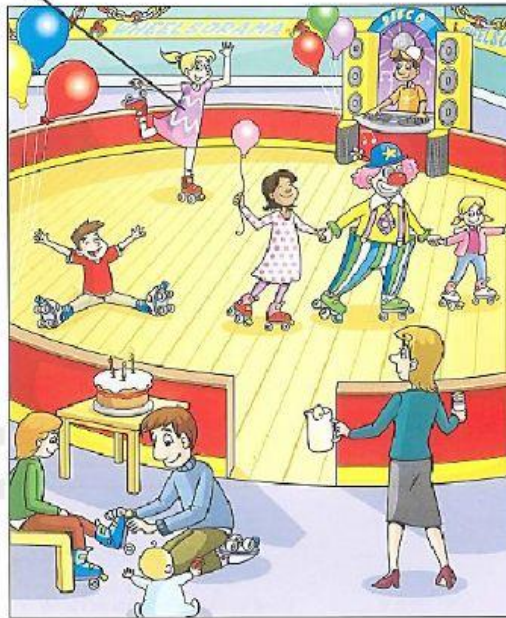
