Simple Future Tense

The Simple Future Tense tells us more about an action or an event that will take place in the future.

Will/Shall are modal verbs. **Will/Shall** are positive modal verbs and **will not / shall not** are negative modal verbs. The modal verb **will/shall** are always followed by a base word. **Shall** is traditionally used with the pronouns 'I' and 'we'.

I we	shall + come = shall come	I we	shall not + send = shall not send
I he she it they we you	will + arrive = will arrive	I he she it they we you	will not + text = will not text
