If someone is "ahead of his or her time," it means that person has done something innovative that has not yet been recognized or properly appreciated. 1 This American woman came up with an idea for something about 120 years ago that every car uses today: the windshield wiper. Her invention is so important that it's hard to imagine a vehicle without a set of wipers. Yet, you've probably never heard of Mary Anderson.

Anderson developed her idea of a windshield wiper while riding a streetcar on a snowy day in New York City. Being from Alabama, she wanted to see the sights of the exciting city. 2 She also noticed the weather was causing problems for the streetcar driver. He had to keep wiping the snow and ice off the windshield with his hands. What's more, he often needed to stick his head out of the window to see where he was going.

3 Her invention involved drivers using levers installed inside the car to control a single rubber blade. The blade moved across windshields, clearing them and making it easier for motorists to see what was happening on the road.

Anderson believed in her design and got a patent for it. 4 Remarkably, several companies rejected her idea. Since cars were not common in 1903, manufacturers didn't see much commercial value in Anderson's invention. It wasn't until a decade or so later, after Henry Ford made automobiles affordable and popular, that people realized windshield wipers were a good idea. Unfortunately, Anderson had already given up trying to interest manufacturers in her idea and allowed her patent to expire.

On the global stage, there is no company that dominates like Amazon. For wide areas of the world, the company is the top choice for online shopping. Though the company has 1 in certain markets, particularly in Asia, it is recognized as a global giant. After all, its annual revenue exceeds US\$300 billion. Even with all of this success, though, Amazon has seen plenty of failures.

In 2013, Amazon announced Prime Air, a special test program that would bring drone delivery into play. These automated aircraft were intended to 2 speedy delivery times within cities and save energy. Amazon named 2018 as the official deadline for wider deployment of the drone delivery program. 3, in 2022, this

still seems a distant dream. Many difficulties have arisen. As an example, early last year, over a hundred employees __4__ on Prime Air were fired. Those employees described a workplace filled with unrealistic expectations.

This is not to say that all drone delivery programs are guaranteed to fail. Wing, a company in Australia, has seen success. Part of the reason for this is the limited area in which Wing carried out its test run and the limited __5__ of products on offer. The company's CEO sees a way to expand Wing's drone deliveries. In the next few years, Wing's plans will be put to the test as the company expands to Finland and grows from its single US location in Virginia to other states. (May Unit 2)
