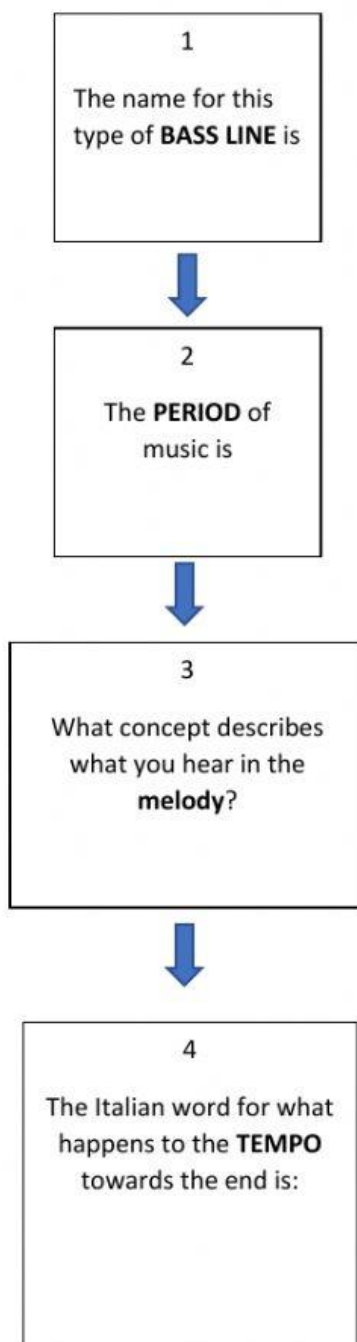
In his question you will hear an excerpt of instrumental music. A guide to the music has been laid out below. You will see that further information is required and you should insert this in each of the four areas.
