C.S. Lewis
Was the author of the famous children's fantasy series *The Chronicles of Narnia*. He was born in Belfast, Ireland in 1898. As a boy, he was interested in mythology, fairy tales and all kinds of books. In 1914 though, World War I started and Lewis went to fight for the UK. After that, he studied at Oxford University before working there for many years. In 1926, he met and became friends with J. R. R. Tolkien. For years, they read and discussed each other's stories. In 1950, Lewis published *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, the first book in *The Chronicles of Narnia*. Lewis died in 1963, but his stories remain some of the most popular in the world.
