He is walking **into** the tunnel.



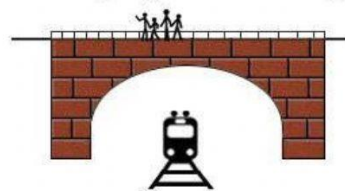
He is walking **out of** the tunnel.



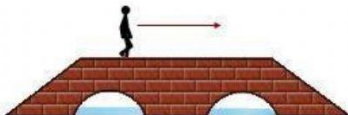
He is walking **through** the tunnel.
