Nghi vấn	Am/Is/Are + S + going to + V-inf + ...? - Yes, S + am/is/are. - No, S + am/is/are + not. *Với Wh-questions: - Wh-questions + am/is/are + S + going to + V-inf + ...?	Are you going to sleep? - Yes, I am. What is he going to do? - He is going to have a party.
