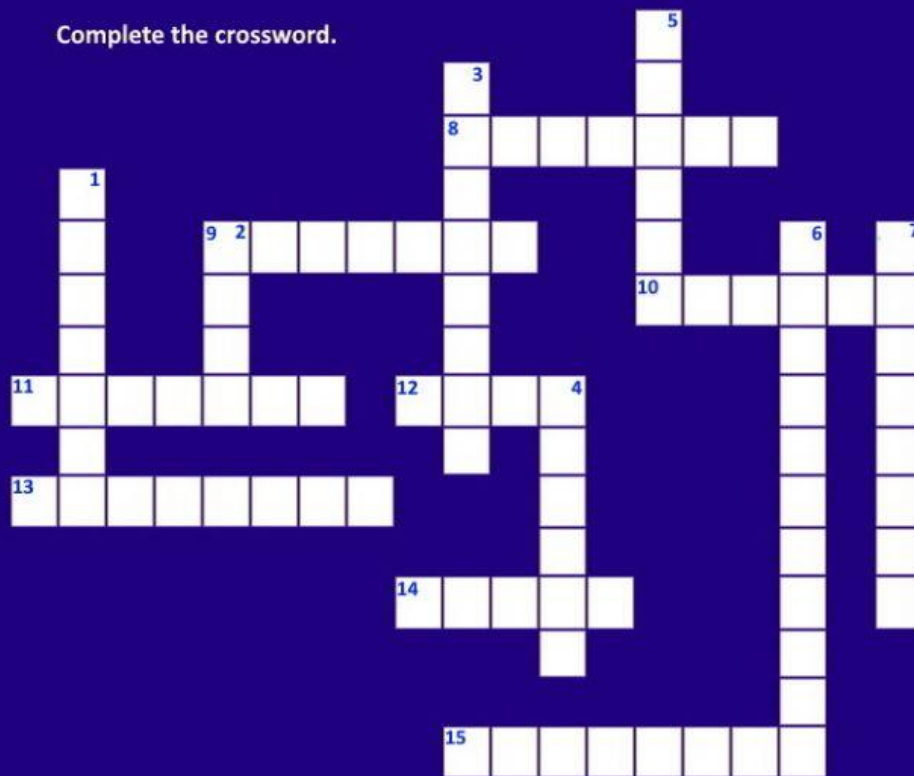


Complete the crossword.
