

Like and Dislike + infinitive and infinitive

✓ I like **to sleep**. like + **infinitive**

✓ I like **sleeping**. like + **verb-ing**

We sometimes use **like + infinitive** to talk about habits or choices.

Like + verb-ing is more common to say you like doing something in general.



✓ I like **to eat** chocolate for breakfast. *(my habit)*

✓ I like **eating** chocolate. *(I like doing this in general)*
