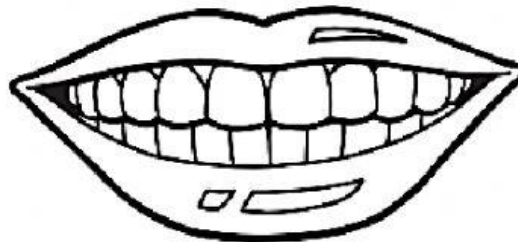
TEETH
