Subject + don't + verb
I don't read
You don't read
We don't read
They don't read

POSITIVE
Subject+verb(s)

He reads
She reads
It reads

Verbs ends in:
“Sh, ch, ss, x, o”
add “es”: goes,
washes, watches
• **Consonant + y**
Study = studies

NEGATIVE
Subject + doen't + verb

He doesn't read
She doesn't read
It doesn't read





VERB TO BE



POSITIVES

Subject + verb to be + verb(ing)

I am reading

We are reading

You are reading

They are reading

He is reading

She is reading

It is reading

NEGATIVES

Subj + verb to be(neg) + Verb(ing)

I am not reading

We are not reading

You are not reading

They are not reading

He is not reading

She is not reading

It is not reading
