Subject + verb

I read

You read

We read

They read

NEGATIVE

Subject + don't + verb

I don't read

You don't read

We don't read

They don't read

IT

POSITIVE

Subject + verb(s)

He reads

She reads

It reads

NEGATIVE

Subject + doesn't + verb

He doesn't read

She doesn't read

It doesn't read

• Consonat + y

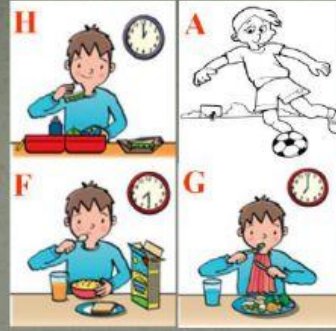
Study = studies

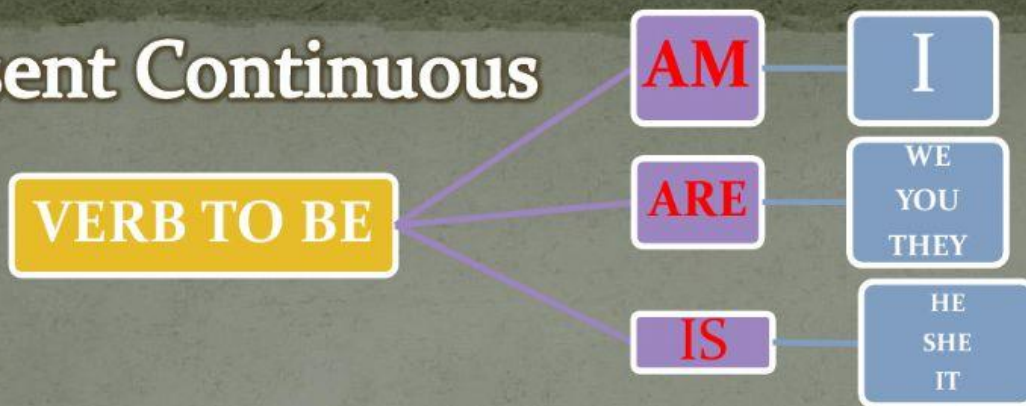

# Present Continuous



POSITIVES	NEGATIVES	QUESTIONS
Subject+ verb to be + verb(ing)	Subj+ verb to be( neg) + Verb(ing)	Verb to be + Subject + verb(ing)?
I am reading	I am not reading	Am I reading?
We are reading	We are not reading	Are we reading?
You are reading	You are not reading	Are you reading?
They are reading	They are not reading	Are they reading?
He is reading	He is not reading	Is he reading?
She is reading	She is not reading	Is she reading?
It is reading	It is not reading	Is it reading?
