


READING TEST

Adam Osborne didn't invent the computer, he invented the first laptop. It was called Osborne 1, and he invented it in 1981. It looked very different from the laptops we have today. It was big and heavy, and it had a very small screen. It couldn't hold a lot of data, but lots of people used it.



Martin Cooper invented and used the first cell phone in April 1973. It was bigger and heavier than cell phones today. It was twenty-three centimeters long, and it weighed more than one kilogram. He got the idea for a cell phone from TV programs about space. He worked with the company Motorola. They made the phone smaller and lighter.
