Viking Warriors

The Vikings are best known for their fierce (scary) warriors. They were excellent fighters, very organised and brave in battle.

Viking warriors are often shown wearing helmets with horns (*sừng/vật nhọn*) but these were not used in fighting. The warriors' helmets were actually smooth and close fitting to the head. They were made of feather or metal.

The axe was a Viking's warrior best weapon but they also used spears (*gáo/mác*) and swords and carried shields. Swords were very special weapons (*vũ khí đặc biệt*) as they were often given to brave warriors who had done well in many battles.
