Read the examples below. Underline the comparative adjectives and put them in the correct columns of the table.

- 1 You feel hungrier when your favorite food is on a white plate.
- 2 When you add red dye to water, it has a sweeter taste than normal water.
- 3 When being asked to serve themselves with pasta, people with red plates took a small portion, while the people with white plates took a much larger/bigger portion.
- 4 Designers often use the color white to make rooms seem larger and more spacious because they are more visible on the roads.
- 5 The food that you think is the most delicious will probably taste worse to you if you change its colour to blue.

Grammatical rule	Example
Adjective with 1 syllable → add -er	sweet →
Adjective with 1 syllable ending in -e → add -r	→
Adjective with 1 syllable ending in a vowel & a consonant → double the consonant & add -er	→
Adjective with 2 syllables ending in -y → turn -y into -ier	→
Adjective with ≥ 2 syllables → more + adjective	spacious → visible →
Irregular adjectives	good → bad → far → many → much → little →

Grammatical rule	Example
Adjective with 1 syllable → add -est	→
Adjective with 1 syllable ending in -e → add -st	→
Adjective with 1 syllable ending in a vowel & a consonant → double the consonant & add -est	→
Adjective with 2 syllables ending in -y → turn -y into -iest	→
Adjective with ≥ 2 syllables → the most + adjective	→ → → →
Irregular adjectives	good → bad → far → many → much → little →
