Present Continuous Tense

- We use the present continuous to talk about things that are happening now.
- We make the present continuous with the **verb + -ing**: play → **playing**.
- How to form the present continuous: 1. Take away the final -e: cycle → **cycling**.
2. Double the consonant after one vowel, one consonant: run → **running**.
