'Today, a lot of people go to university when they finish school, but it was difficult when I was young. My friends and I finished school at 18, and there weren't any good jobs. I worked in a shop for two years. I was 20 when I got a job in the bank, and I had to work hard. I'm the manager now, but it wasn't easy to get to this position – I went to night school and did some extra courses.'

Olivia Johnson is Karen's daughter. She's a student, and she's 18 next week. She lives in Leith, a town near Edinburgh, Scotland, with some friends. Her parents and her brother live in a house nearby.

'I like being a teenager,' says Olivia. 'I have good friends and a really nice boyfriend. I don't go out very often, but I text my friends all the time or we chat online. On weekdays, I meet my friends in a café near my school, or I watch films at my boyfriend's house. Sometimes we go to a cinema on Saturday night. I usually wear comfortable clothes – T-shirts and jeans, and I download a lot of music from the internet.'
