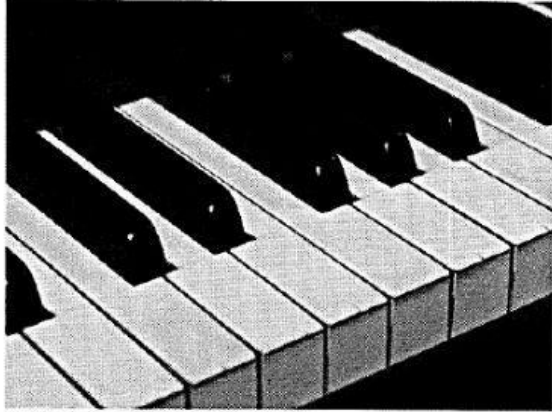

The giant piano
