


DIRECTIONS. Complete the concept map below by dragging boxes on the right to the dark-colored ones.

Is the measure of the energy released by the origin of the earthquake.

4 - 4.9  
Light

Is the instrument used to measure the magnitude of an earthquake.

5 - 5.9  
Moderate

Is an open-ended logarithmic scale for expressing the magnitude of an earthquake..

Destructive in areas up to 160 km, damage to well-built structures.

Can be detected only by seismograph.

7 - 7.9  
Major

2 - 2.9  
Minor

Can cause serious damage several hundred miles across.

Comparable to the vibrations of a passing truck.
