- 3 Why does she like spending time with the people in the photo?

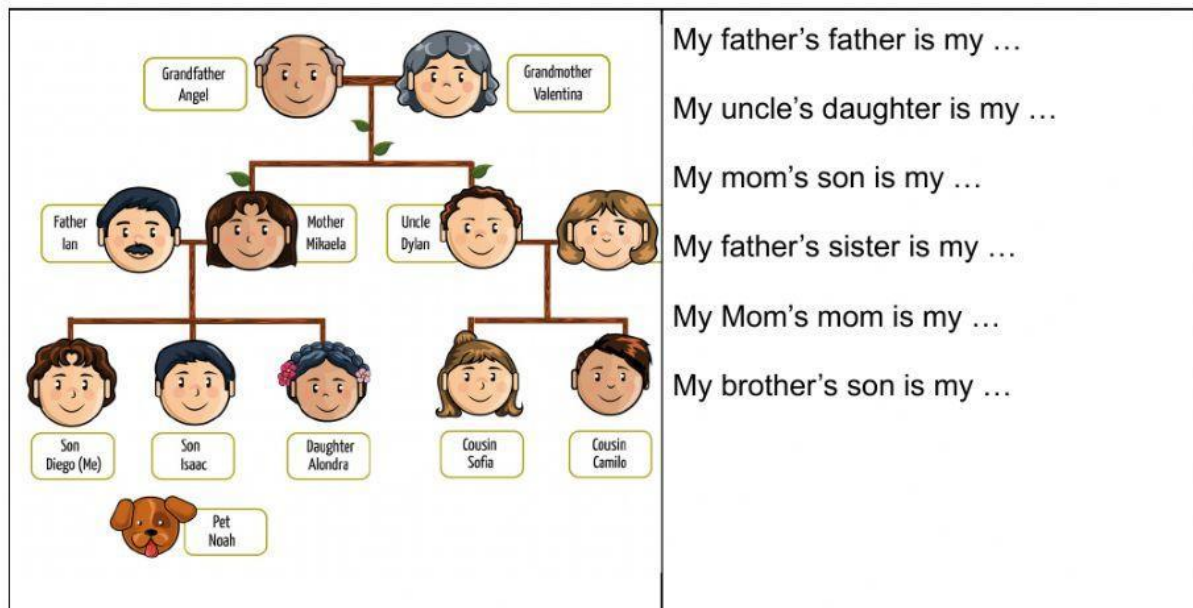
In your notebook:
