- 1 Use *this* / *these* for things near you (*here*).
- 2 Use *that* / *those* for things which aren't near you (*there*).
- *this* / *that* = singular; *these* / *those* = plural.
- *this*, *that*, *these*, and *those* can be adjectives (*this* watch) or pronouns (*What's this?*).
