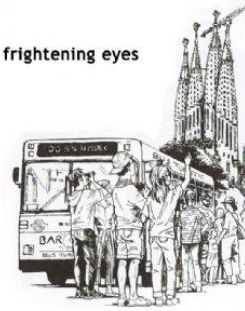


Spanish adventure

WORD LIST with example sentences

bin (n) We don't want that old food. Put it in the *bin*.

corner (n) The shop is on the *corner* of New Street and Oxford Street.

dangerous (adj) Don't go near the animals; they are *dangerous*.

drug (n) The police stopped her. Now she's at the police station because she had *drugs* in her bag.

something (pron) There's *something* on the floor. What is it?

thought (v) He didn't *think* about people; he only *thought* about money.

through (prep, adv) Did he come in *through* the door or the window?

took (v) I didn't take much money with me, but he *took* a lot.

fell (v) He *fell* off his bicycle yesterday.

frightened (adj) Some children are *frightened* of dark rooms. Dark rooms can be *frightening*.

gun (n) Get down! That man's got a *gun*!

hold (v) She *held* his hand, and they walked across the road.
