SUBJECT	I	YOU	WE	THEY
?	Did you play?			
+	I played			
-	I didn't play			
✓ ✗	Yes, I did. No, I didn't			

PAST SIMPLE (THIRD PERSON)

SUBJECT	HE	SHE	IT
?	Did he play?		
+	He played		
-	He didn't play		
✓ ✗	Yes, he did. No, he didn't		

THEORY

PAST SIMPLE- USES

- I went there last summer → Finished actions, that happened once or + in the past
- I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they went → Same form
- I played → regular -ed
- I didn't → negative form
- Did I infin. → Question form
- Remember the order using:  
ASI: Auxiliary+Subject+Infinitive  
 or  
QuASI: Question Word+Auxiliary+Subject+Infinitive
  - Did you go?
  - When did you go?
