In 1922, two Englishmen, Howard Carter and Lord Carnarvon, went to the Valley of the Kings. On 4th November, one of Carter's men found something...

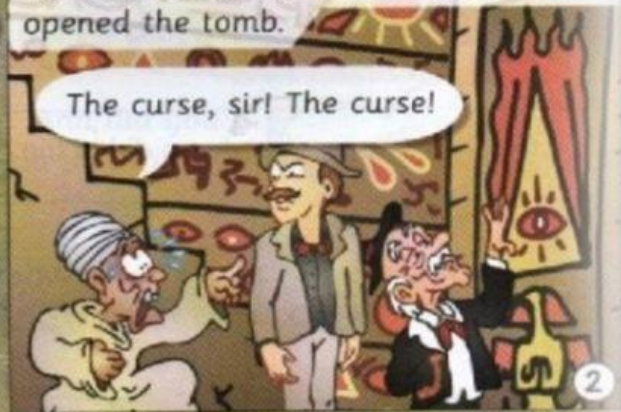
Look, sir!

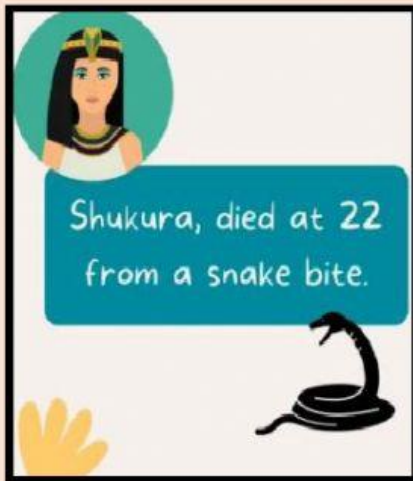
