Understanding Numerator and Denominator

$\frac{\mathbf{5}}{6}$	$\frac{7}{\mathbf{6}}$	$\frac{1}{\mathbf{3}}$	$\frac{\mathbf{3}}{15}$	$\frac{2}{\mathbf{9}}$

$\frac{6}{\mathbf{9}}$	$\frac{\mathbf{10}}{15}$	$\frac{\mathbf{2}}{4}$	$\frac{1}{\mathbf{8}}$	$\frac{\mathbf{5}}{12}$

Identify whether the object shown is divided **equally** or **unequally** by typing "equal" or "unequal" on the line!
