- Temporarily relieves nasal congestion due to the common cold, hay fever or other upper respiratory allergies, or associated with sinusitis
- Temporarily relieves these symptoms due to hay fever (allergic rhinitis):
 - runny nose

 - itching of the nose or throat
 - itchy, watery eyes
- Temporarily restores freer breathing through the nose

Directions

Do not take more than 4 doses in any 24- hour period

Age Dose adults and children over 12 years	4 tsp every 4 hours
Children 6 to under 12 years	2 tsp every 4 hours
