

THEORY (verb/particle/object)

WORD ORDER OF PHRASAL VERBS - USES

I get **up** at 8.00 →

1. V+P (no object)
(preposition or adverb)
Some **don't have an object**

Put **on** your coat/
put your coat **on**

Turn **on** the TV
Turn the TV **on**

2. V+P+O/V+O + P (separable)
Some have an object and are separable (**on, off..**)

Look ~~it~~ for it →

3. V+P+O (inseparable)
Some have an object and it is **never separated**

Put **it** on, ~~put on it~~
Turn **it** off, ~~turn off it~~

4. V+O.P+ P (Pronoun)
With an **object pronoun**, it always goes between verb and participle
