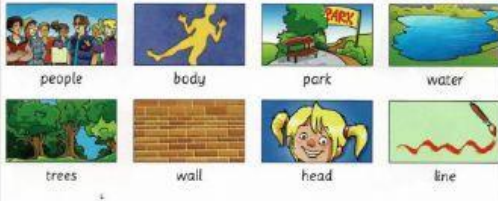


Some people say that spiders are ugly, but some say that they are beautiful. A spider has got eight eyes on its (1) and eight long legs on its (2)
