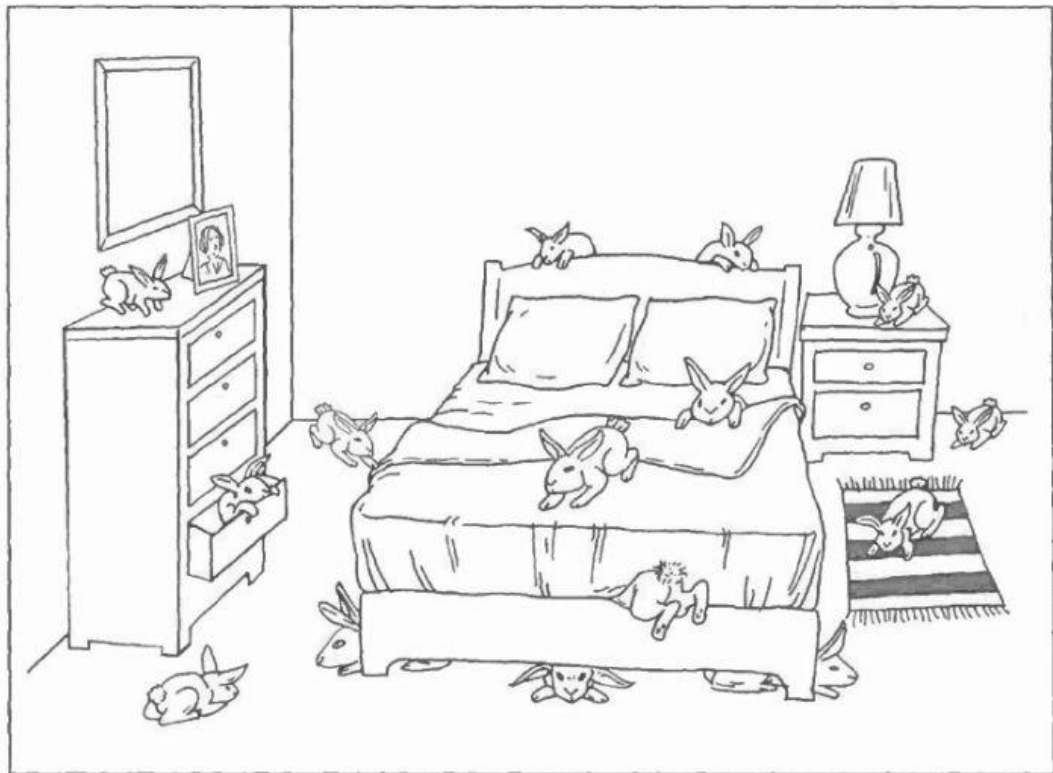

Mario wants a pet. He doesn't want a dog. He doesn't want a cat. He doesn't want a bird.



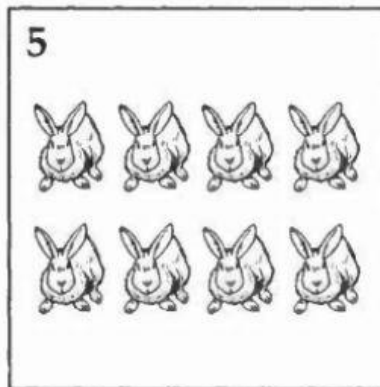
He wants a rabbit.



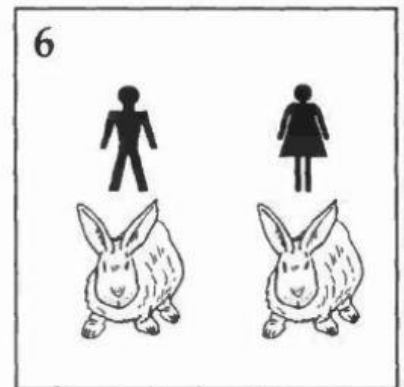
He buys two rabbits.



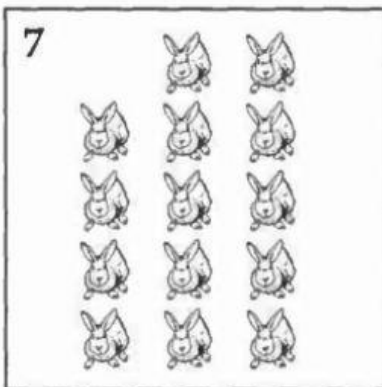
Are the rabbits male or female? Mario doesn't know.



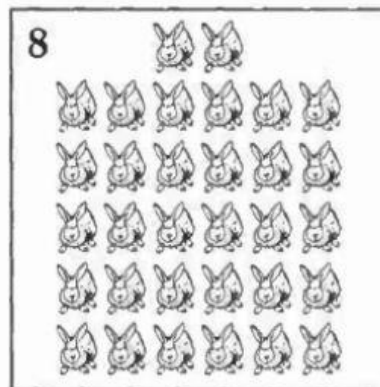
In one month, Mario has eight rabbits.



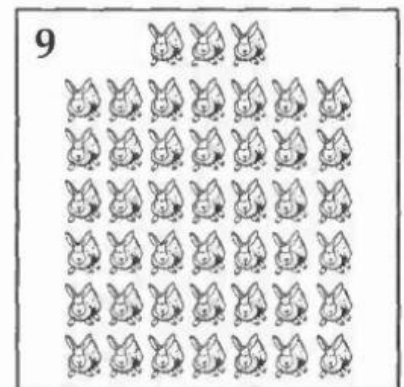
Now Mario knows: One rabbit is male, and the other rabbit is female.



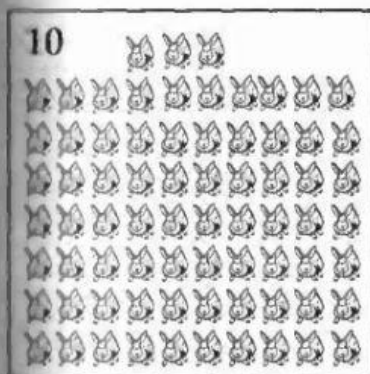
In three months, Mario has 14 rabbits. It's OK; Mario likes rabbits.

In nine months, Mario has 45 rabbits. It's OK; Mario likes rabbits.



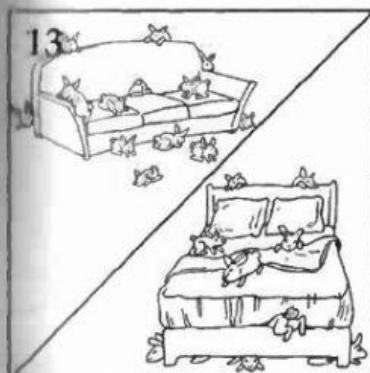
In one year, Mario has 73 rabbits. Now it's not OK.



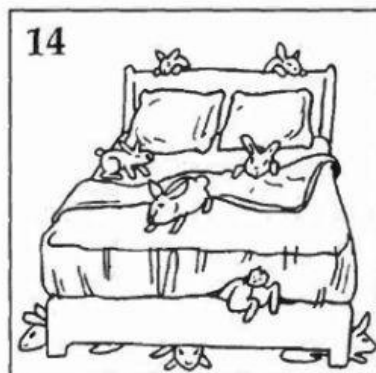
There are rabbits everywhere in Mario's house.



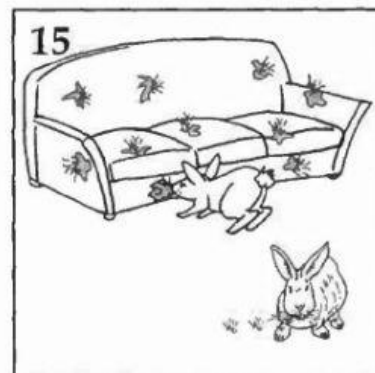
They are in the kitchen and in the bathroom.

They are on Mario's bed, and in Mario's bed, and under Mario's bed.



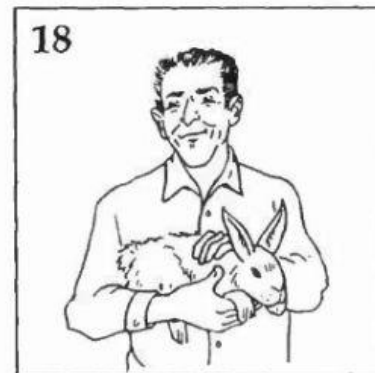
They eat his sofa.



"I like rabbits," Mario says. "But I don't want 73 rabbits!"



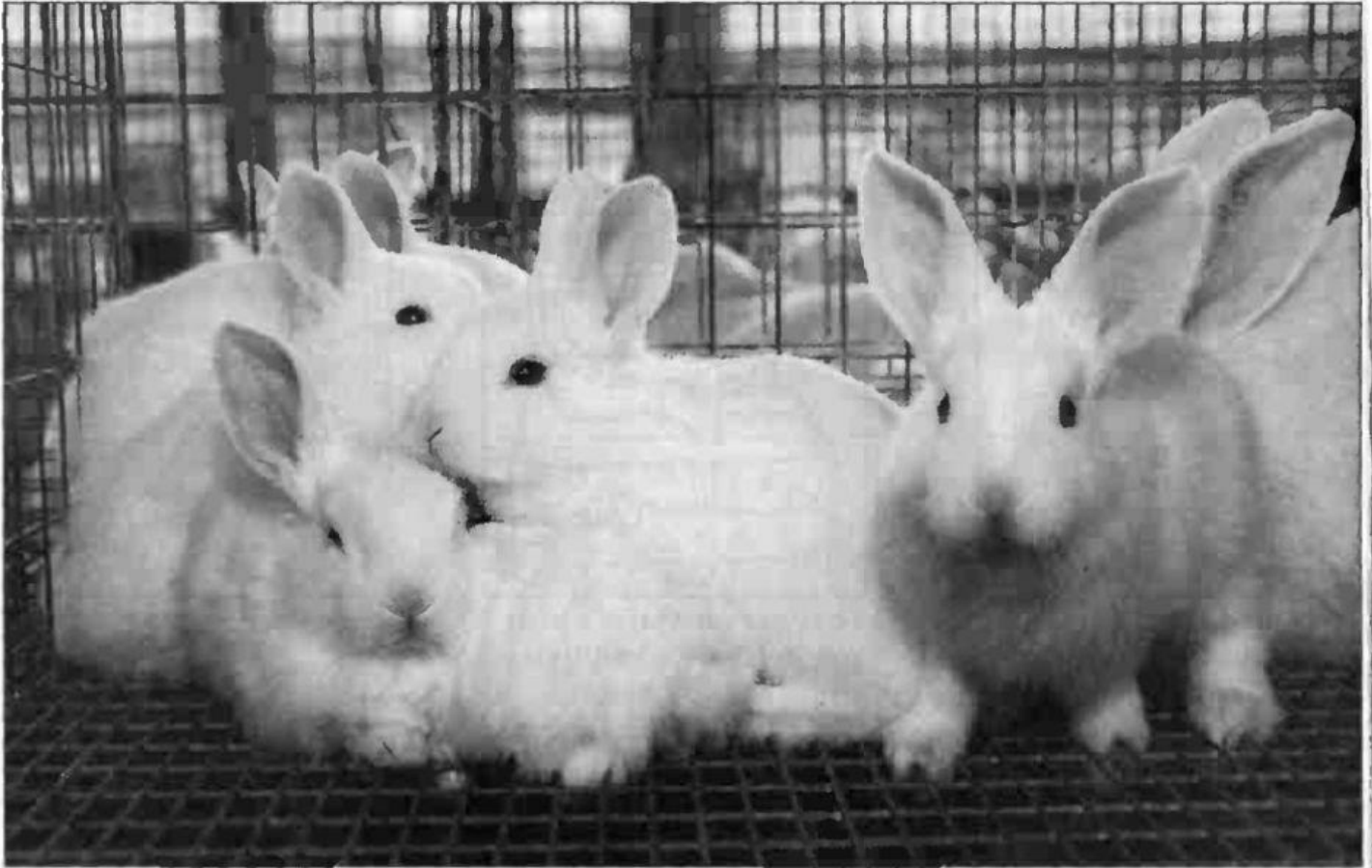
People come to Mario's house. They take the rabbits.

Mario's Rabbits
