Prepositions before nouns (Giới từ đứng trước danh từ)

1. Giới từ đứng trước danh từ: Một vài giới từ trong tiếng Anh được sử dụng để liên kết các danh từ và tính từ trong câu.

2. Một số giới từ đứng trước danh từ phổ biến:

- Giới từ chỉ địa điểm: **in** (ở trong), **on** (ở trên), **at** (tại đâu), **to** (đến), **behind** (đằng sau), **under** (bên dưới), **next to** (bên cạnh), **between** (ở giữa), etc.

Ex: He's **at** the train station. (Cậu ấy đang ở ga xe lửa.)

The bakery is **between** my house and his house. (Tiệm bánh ở giữa nhà tôi và nhà cậu ấy.)

- Giới từ chỉ tác nhân hay phương tiện: **with** (bằng), **by** (bằng, bởi), etc.

Ex: She cut the cake **with** a plastic knife. (Cô ấy cắt bánh bằng chiếc dao nhựa.)

- Giới từ chỉ sự liên hệ hoặc đồng hành: **with** (cùng với)

Ex: I went to the concert **with** my brother. (Tôi đến buổi hòa nhạc cùng em trai.)

- Giới từ chỉ xu hướng của hành động:

+ **Into** (miêu tả sự di chuyển vào bên trong một sự vật khác)

Ex: The children jumped **into** the pool. (Lũ trẻ nhảy vào bể bơi.)

+ **From...to...** (miêu tả sự di chuyển từ nơi này sang nơi khác)

Ex: **From East to West** (Từ Đông sang Tây)

+ **Along** (dọc theo)

Ex: Go **along** the street (Đi dọc theo con phố)

+ **Out of** (ra khỏi)

Ex: He got **out of** the house. (Anh ấy ra khỏi nhà.)

+ **Through** (đi qua)

Ex: Mary walked **through** the door. (Mary đi qua cánh cửa.)

3. Một số giới từ đi kèm tính từ (đứng trước danh từ) phổ biến:

+ **Interested in** (hứng thú với điều gì)

Ex: I'm **interested in** football. (Tôi thấy hứng thú với bóng đá.)

+ **Afraid of** (sợ điều gì)

Ex: He's **afraid of** spiders. (Anh ấy sợ nhện.)

+ **Good/ bad at** (giỏi/ tệ điều gì)

Ex: Kate's **good at** tennis. (Kate chơi tennis giỏi.)

+ **Ready for** (sẵn sàng với điều gì)

Ex: I'm **ready for** the challenge. (Tôi sẵn sàng với thử thách rồi.)

+ **Keen on** (yêu thích điều gì)

Ex: She's **keen on** music. (Cô ấy thích âm nhạc.)

+ **Proud of** (tự hào về điều gì)

Ex: Tom's **proud of** his achievements. (Tom rất tự hào về thành tích của mình.)
