


# POINTS OF ARTICULATION AND ARTICULATORS IN ENGLISH

Points of articulation and their articulators in english

1. Bilabial (upper and lower lips)
2. Labiodental (lower lip and upper teeth)
3. Dental (tip of the tongue between the teeth) = interdental
4. Alveolar (tip of the tongue and alveolar ridge)
5. Palatal (front of the tongue and hard palate)
6. Velar (back of the tongue and soft palate or velum)
7. Glottal (vocal cords)
