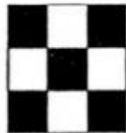

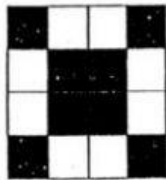
1. Find the number A such that the following statement is true:

3. In the following pattern, how many black squares are there in the 19th image?

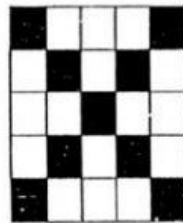
1st Image



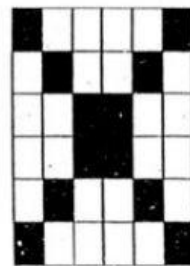
2nd Image
