Future Conditional

We use the Future Conditional to talk about possible future events, when they depend on other future events:

If it rains, we'll stay at home.

They may leave without us if we're late.

Form

if + present simple,
(condition)

will/may + infinitive
(consequence)

will/may + infinitive
(consequence)

if + present simple
(condition)

We use the Present Simple (not *will*) after *when, before* and *as soon as* to talk about the future:

I'll help you when I come home.

Before they start cooking, they'll clean the kitchen.
