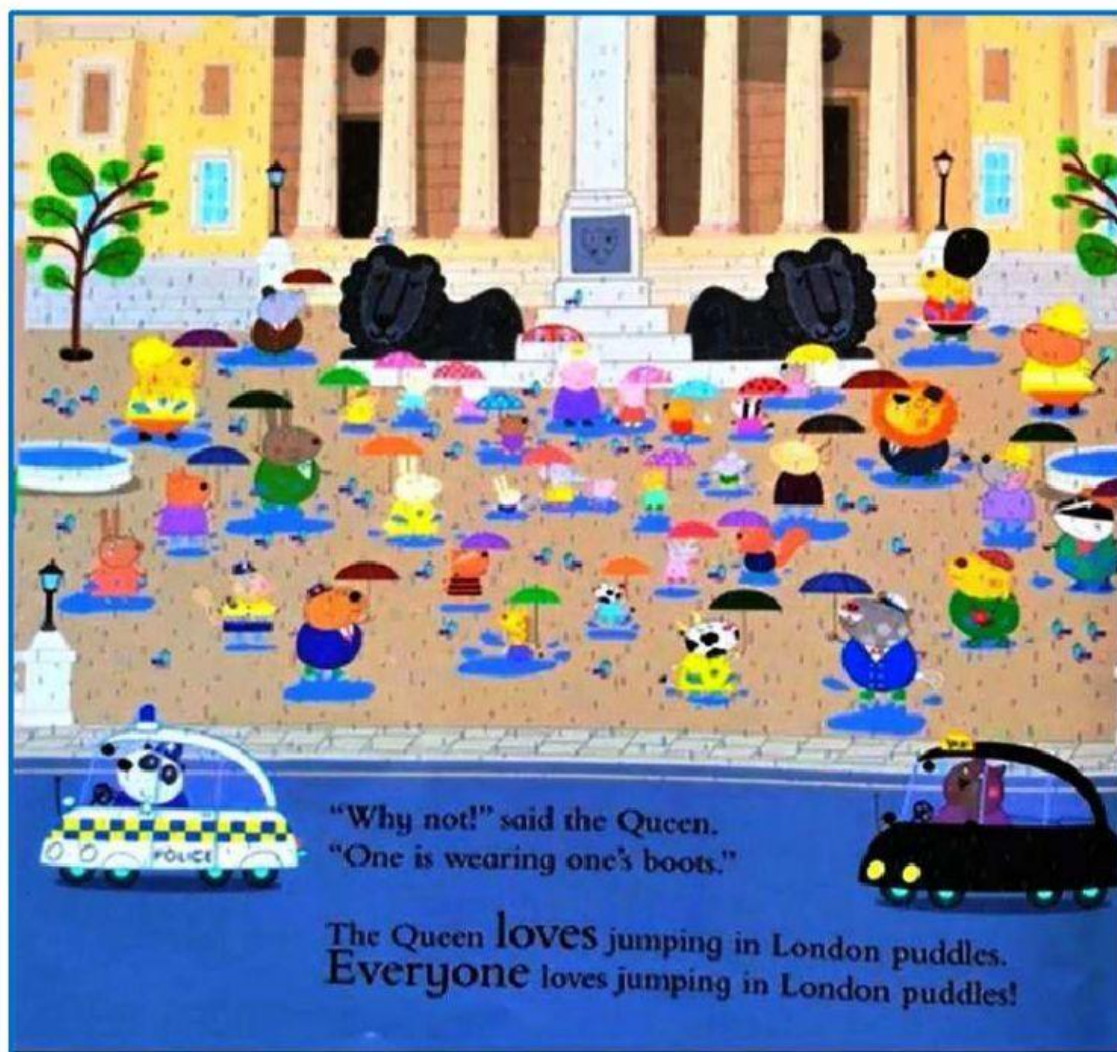
The bus chugged through the rain to Trafalgar Square.

 "Awwwww!" groaned the children as they climbed off the bus.



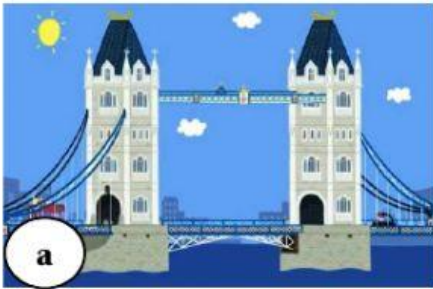
