Introduction

1	Because we are human, we all make mistakes.
2	It is not easy to get along with everyone all the time.
3	Sometimes we hurt people's feelings without intending to.
4	Sometimes, we do something wrong and regret it later.
5	When that happens, what should we do?
6	We should apologize.
7	Read the following case studies and learn three things about a proper apology. *case studies : 사례연구들

The importance of sincere apology

8	When June tripped over a backpack and fell, Mike found it funny and laughed . *find+목적어+형용사 : 목적어가 ~하다는 것을 깨닫다.
9	He took a picture and uploaded it on an SNS.
10	June saw the picture and became angry.
11	Mike said, with a laugh, "Sorry, June!" and deleted it.
12	After that, June felt even more hurt because of Mike's casual apology.
13	June didn't like how Mike had acted. *How +주어 + 동사 : 어떻게 ~하는지
14	Mike seemed to think it was nothing serious .
15	What did you learn from this case?

16	Yes. You guessed right. You should be sincere when you apologize.
17	Apologizing is necessary to build good friendships.
18	Saying you're sorry is more than just words.
19	You need to show that you respect the other person and care about his or her feelings.
20	If you truly want to make things right , be sincere in your apology. *Make+목적어+형용사 : 목적어가 ~하게 만들다
21	The more sincere your apology is, the better it will be received . *The + 비교급 + 주어 + 동사 ~, The + 비교급 + 주어 + 동사 ~ : ~할수록 ~하다

The importance of quick apology

22	Here is another case.
23	While Kate was hurrying across the cafeteria, she accidentally bumped into Hojun. *hurry across : 서둘러 지나가다
24	Some food on Hojun's tray fell on his jacket.
25	Kate didn't apologize.
26	Hojun felt bad.
27	He thought, 'Why doesn't she say something?'
28	It would be nothing if she apologized right now.'
29	This case shows that when an apology is necessary, you should apologize at once .
30	A quick apology shows that you are thoughtful and take responsibility for your action.

31	All you need to do is to say, "I'm sorry."
32	Then, the hurt friend will think nothing of it and laugh it off .

The importance of apology among family members and loved ones

33	Finally, apologies are necessary among family members and loved ones, too. *among : 셋이상의 사이에서
34	One day, Sunmin borrowed her sister's favorite book.
35	Later, she lost it.
36	Sunmin didn't apologize because she thought it was not important.
37	She thought, 'We're sisters, after all .'
38	Sunmin's sister disliked how Sunmin had treated her. *How + 주어 + 동사 : 어떻게 ~하는지
39	How could her own sister ignore her feelings?
40	This was not the first time Sunmin hadn't apologized to her little sister.
41	People need to apologize when they do something wrong.
42	This includes family members and the people who are close to you.
43	People get hurt more easily when the hurt comes from a family member or a friend.
44	We may think that they will let it go because they are close to us. *let it go : ~넘어가다

45	Remember, however, that small mistakes and no apology add up to big emotional wounds . *add up to : (결과가) ~가 되다
46	This is especially true among family members and loved ones.

Conclusion

47	Have you ever heard of the saying, "No more apologies, no more chances"?
48	People make mistakes, but don't let one mistake break a beautiful relationship . *let+목+동사원형 : (목적어)가 ~게 하다.
49	Do you want to apologize to someone?
50	Try to do it now. *Try+to+동사원형 : 하려고 노력해라.
51	A quick and sincere "I'm sorry" can solve many problems.
