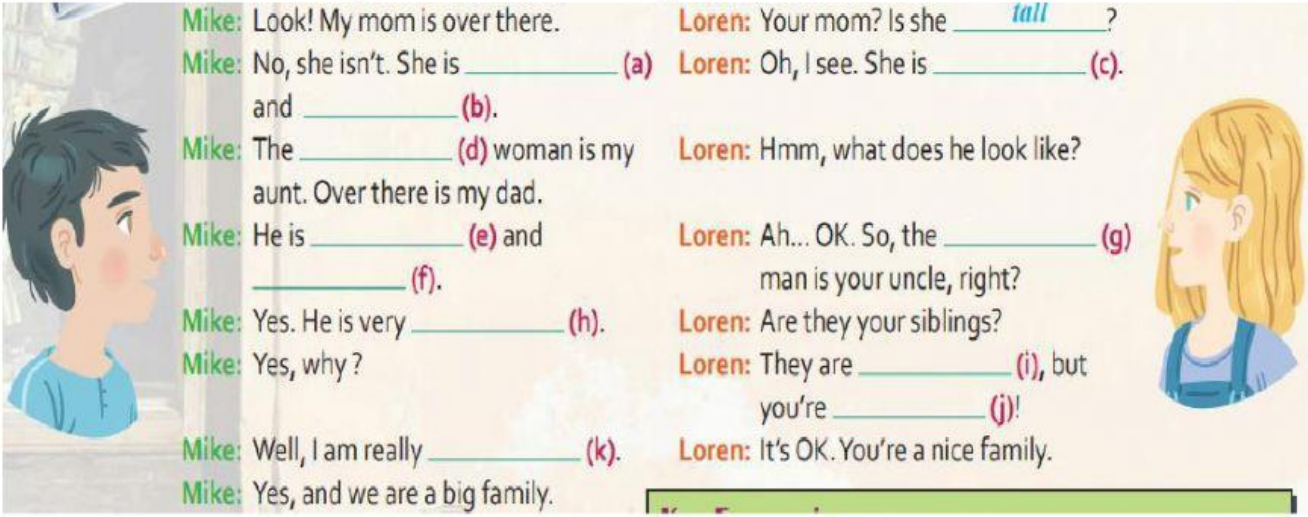


Listening information

Mike: Yes, why?

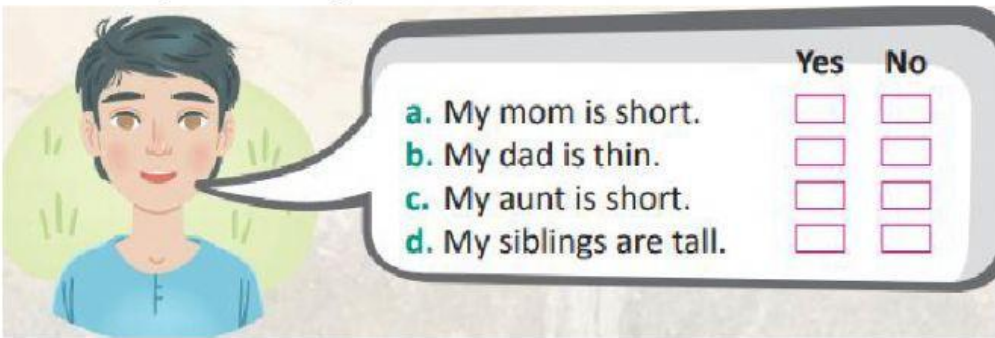
Loren: They are (i), but you're (j)!
