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GLOBAL ENGLISH 6: UNIT 2 – SPORT GRAMMAR 1

A. NEW LESSON

First conditional sentence with IF/ UNLESS (Câu điều kiện loại 1 với IF/ UNLESS)

1. Câu điều kiện loại 1: được sử dụng để diễn tả một sự việc, hiện tượng có khả năng xảy ra trong hiện tại hoặc tương lai.

2. Câu điều kiện loại 1 với IF:

	Mệnh đề If (Nếu)	Mệnh đề chính (thì)
Công thức	If + S + V (s, es)...	S + will/ won't + V-inf. <i>(won't = will not)</i>
Cách dùng	Nói về một điều kiện có thể xảy ra trong hiện tại hoặc tương lai	Nói về một kết quả có thể xảy ra trong hiện tại hoặc tương lai nếu điều kiện mệnh đề If xảy ra

***Note:** Hai mệnh đề trong câu điều kiện có thể đổi chỗ cho nhau được: nếu mệnh đề chính đứng trước thì giữa hai mệnh đề không cần dấu phẩy, ngược lại thì phải có dấu phẩy ở giữa.

Ex: If it rains, I will stay at home. (Nếu trời mưa, thì tôi sẽ ở nhà.)

We will miss our flight if we don't hurry up. (Chúng ta sẽ muộn chuyến bay nếu chúng ta không nhanh lên.)

3. Câu điều kiện loại 1 với UNLESS:

Cấu trúc **UNLESS** tương đương với **IF NOT**, vì vậy trong câu điều kiện, 2 từ này có thể thay thế cho nhau. Mặc dù **UNLESS** mang nghĩa phủ định nhưng nó lại được sử dụng trong câu khẳng định.

Ex: If John isn't tired, we will go out. (Nếu Tom không mệt, thì chúng tôi sẽ ra ngoài.)

→ Unless John is tired, we will go out. (Trừ khi Tom mệt, chúng tôi sẽ ra ngoài.)

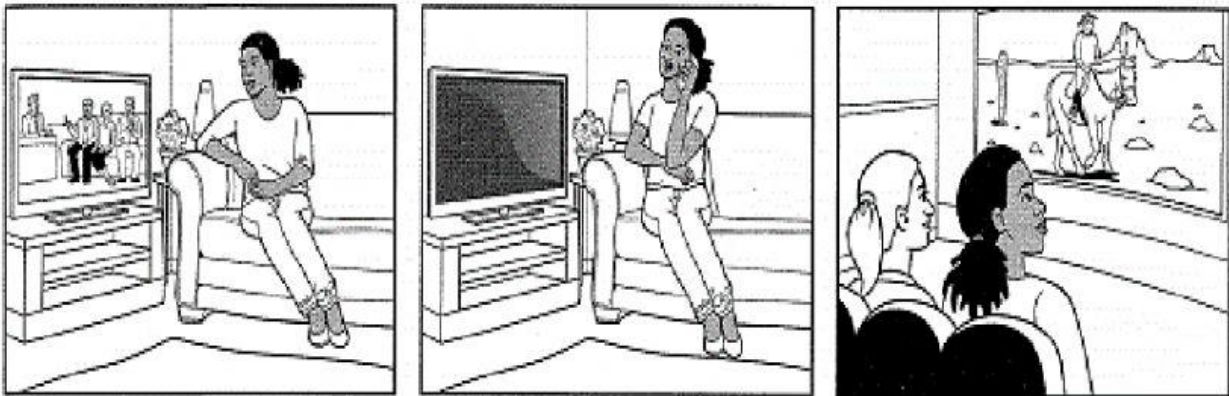
