

BE GOOD AT + V_ING / NOUN - GIỚI CÁI GÌ ĐÓ

Affirmative sentence: S + be (is/am/are/was/were) + V_ing / noun

EX: Bears are good at climbing.

Neative sentece: S + be (is/am/are/was/were) + not + V_ing/noun

Ex: I am not good at Maths = I'm not good at Maths

Ex: She is not good at singing = She isn't good at dancing

Question: Be (is/am/are/was/were) (+ not) + S + V_ing/noun

Ex: Is your mom good at cooking?
