19. His friend invited him **(go)** on a trip to his hometown last month.

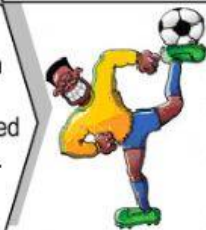
