### LESSON 3 MODALS FOR RULES

To talk about rules in a place we can use a variety of modals. Use the modals *have to* and *must* to express obligation. *Don't have to* expresses lack of necessity, while *should* and *shouldn't* express advice. *Can* expresses a possibility and *can't* a prohibition. *Mustn't* also expresses a prohibition but it is used in a more formal situation.
