LESSON 4

PAST PERFECT AND SIMPLE PAST

To express that one past event happened before another past event, we use the past perfect. We form it with the auxiliary *had* plus the past participle of the main verb. To form the negative, add *not* to the auxiliary *had*.

Mary had left the house before her sister arrived.

Helen was sure she hadn't locked the door.

He had finished his homework when you arrived.
