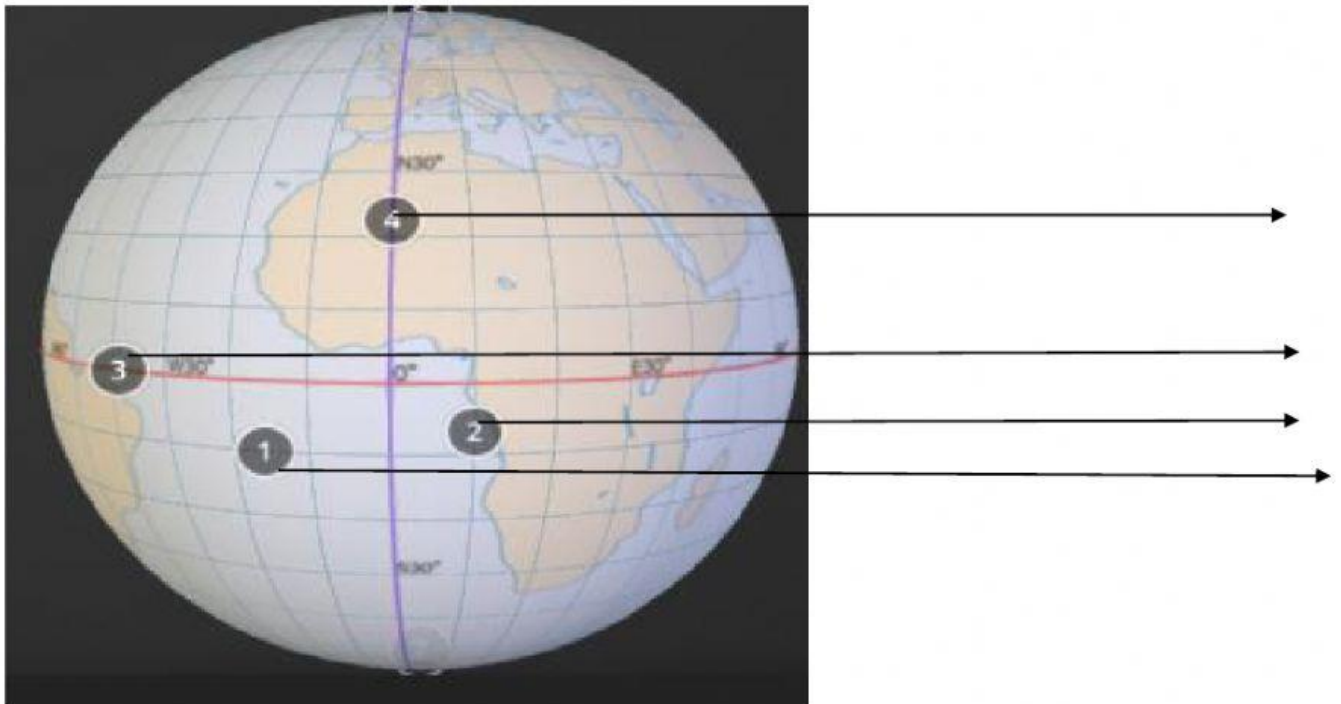

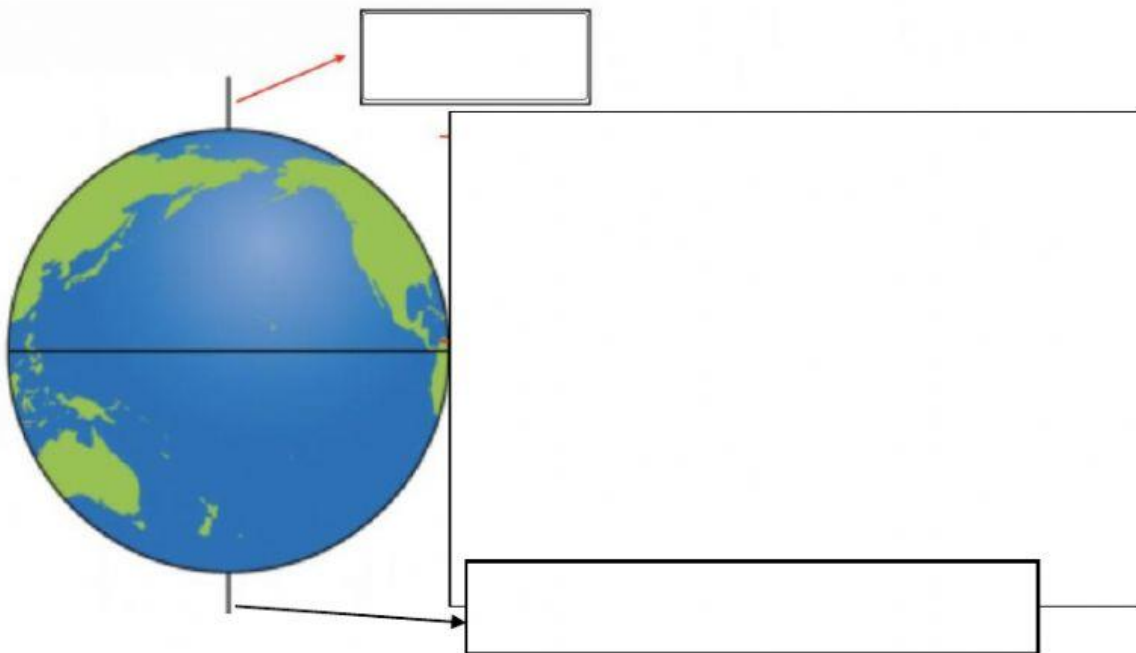
Political Science		Describes the location of a place based on a fixed point on earth

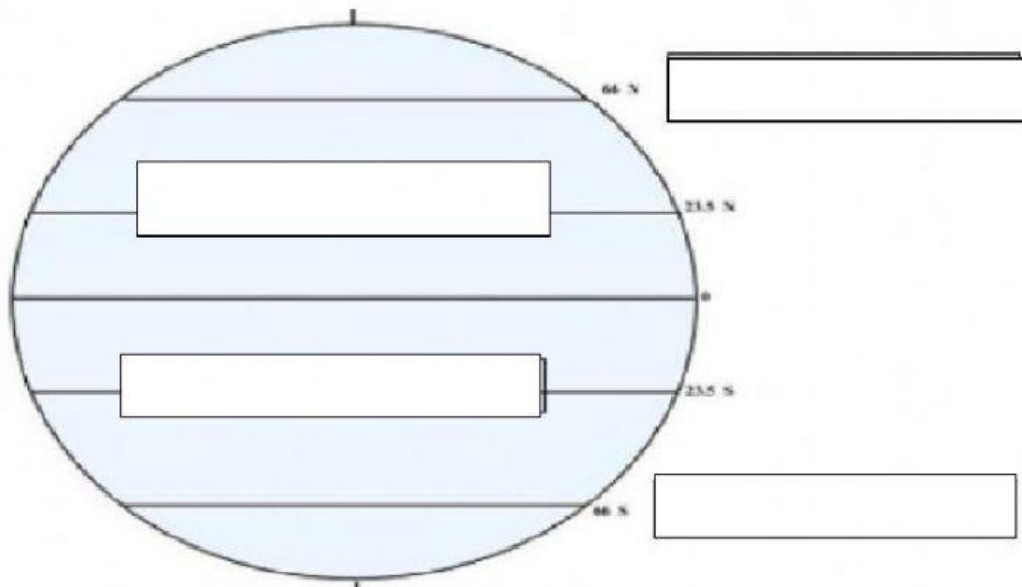

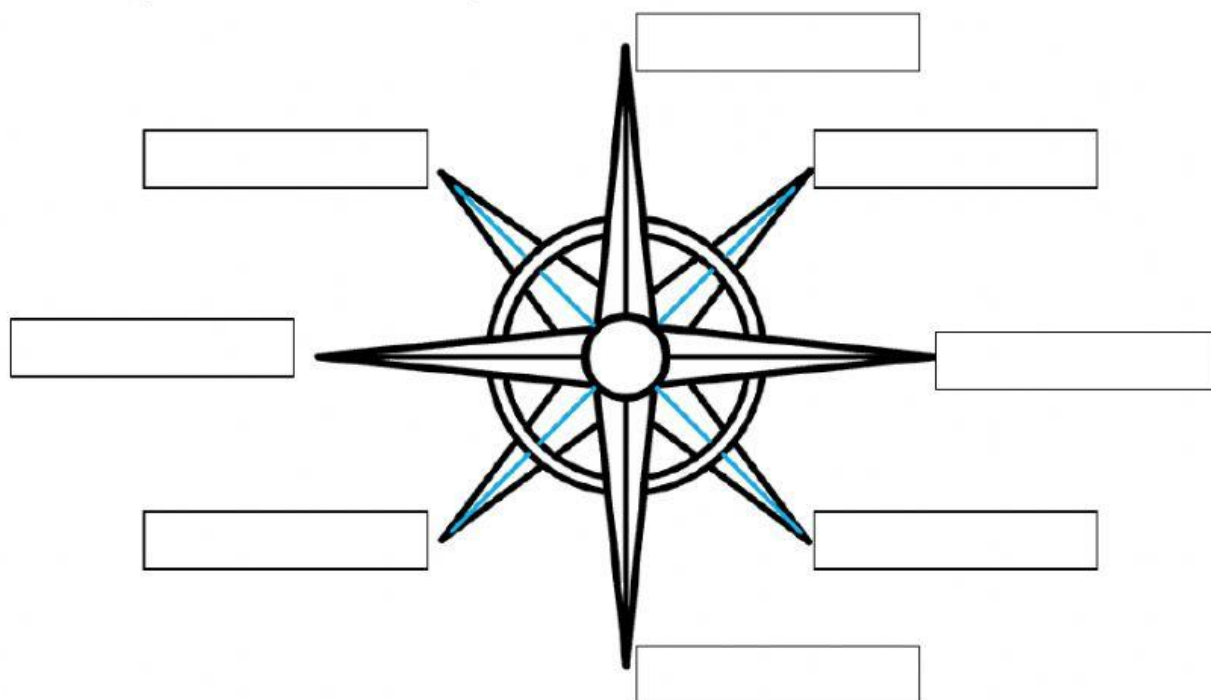
