

# LOGIC GAME - SPRING FLOWERS

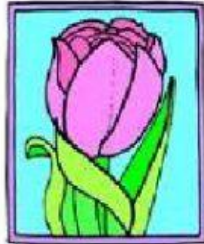


Some elementary information and the instruction.

5. James' family name isn't James, and Jenny doesn't live in London Road.
6. The friend who lives in London Road doesn't bring daisies.
