

**Day Light floor lamp description****Model: M5687****Simulates natural daylight**

Provides ideal illumination for desks, tables, reading, making handicrafts

- designed for use in dry, indoor rooms
- should be used according to the information contained in the instruction manual
- can be used by children but only when supervised by adults

- becomes very hot in a short time – risk of burning
- has changeable bulbs – must be allowed to cool before changing
- cannot be used when there is any visible damage to the cable
- must not be covered with other material – risk of fire
- should be kept away from all heat sources

1. Then fill the tin – make sure that there is an equal covering of the mixture in the tin. Put the tin into the pre-heated oven and bake it for about 45 minutes.
2. First heat the oven to 180 degrees Celsius. Prepare a cake tin by lining it with baking paper. Put the tin to one side while you mix all the ingredients.
3. Place the eggs, butter, sugar and flour in a medium-sized bowl. Remember to follow the directions contained in the recipe. Next, mix all the ingredients, using an electric blender at medium speed until smooth.
4. When the cake is ready, decorate it with icing and coloured sugar, edible glitter or pearls.
