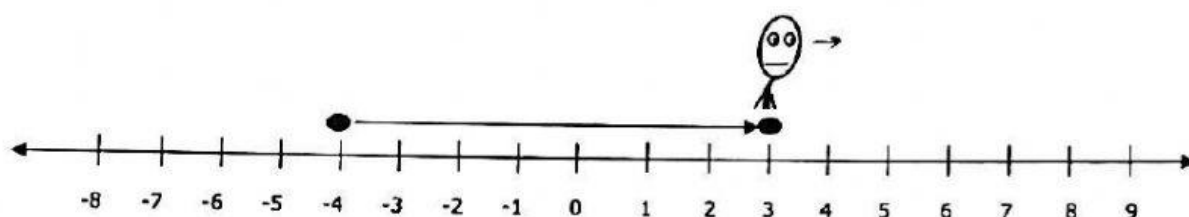
Adding integers

* Modeling adding integers on number lines

- ❖ Step 1: Plot Beginning location.
- ❖ Step 2: Make face to look at the RIGHT.
- ❖ Step 3: Move _____ OR _____.

Example: Modeling $-4 + 7$ on a number line

- Step 1: Locate -4 on the number line for a man's beginning location.
- Step 2: Addition sign (+) means the man has his face to look at the right.
- Step 3: Since 7 is positive then he walks FORWARD by 7 units. That is, count 7 units to the right of -4 , which is 3.



* Rules of adding Integers

- ❖ Rule 1: If the signs of numbers are the same, ADD the absolute value of the numbers and keep the same sign.

Example: (1) $4 + 5 = 9$

(2) $-4 + (-5) =$

- ❖ Rule 2: If the signs are different, SUBTRACT the absolute value of the numbers and take the sign of the number with bigger absolute value.

Example: (1) $-4 + 5 =$

(2) $4 + (-5) =$

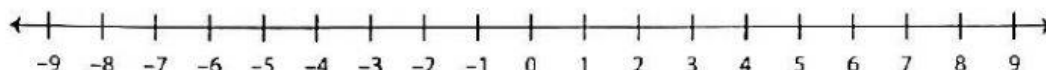
